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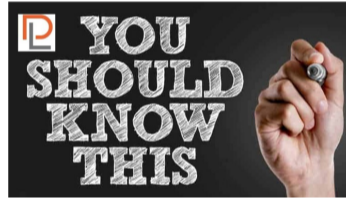
#### Canada's COVID-19: How to get your tax refund as quickly as possible amid the COVID-19 crisis

### TAX FILING DEADLINE EXTENSION

- Personal tax returns filing June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020
- Personal tax payment deadline September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020
- Corporate tax payment September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020
